



How to Obtain a Meter Reset Permit For Storm-Damage

(Via telephone, e-mail, or in person)

******Permit fees for storm-damage repairs caused by Hurricane Irma have been temporarily waived in Orange County******

1. Meter Reset permits are issued when there are no repairs needed to the electrical system and to determine it is safe to be reenergize (only). This is a one-time inspection to set the meter.
2. Meter Resets can be obtained by anyone – Contractors, Homeowners, Tenants or Agents. No need to verify ownership, or confirm that the property is not listed under an LLC.
3. If the inspector finds that work or repairs are required before releasing the meter, an electrical repair permit will be required.

******NOTE: The inspector must be able gain entry into the building, to perform an inspection. It is very important to notate Building, Suite or Unit numbers for power release purposes******
