  -  Residents who are disabled and seeking Social Security or other long-term benefits.
  -  Experiencing an overwhelming or unavoidable crisis that could last more than one month.

-  Advocating for clients in an effort to obtain needed services.
  -  Financial assistance/budget counseling.
  -  Providing clients with information about community resources and linking them with other programs.
  -  Home visits are conducted with individuals and/or families at their residence in order to make situational assessments and determine family needs.
