

## **FEMA Elevation Certificate**

Please note that this project has been identified as being developed in the flood plain and that a properly completed FEMA Elevation Certificate will be required at two points during construction which are:

The first Elevation Certificate is to be provided to the Building Division while the building
is under construction as part of the Building Division's 135 Inspection; which is to be
schedule after the lowest finished floor has been placed. Additionally, scheduling of any
vertical type inspection will not be possible until a 135 inspection has been completed
and approved.

**Note:** Section C of the Elevation Certificate must be marked as **Building Under Construction.**

• The **second** Elevation Certificate is to be provided to the Stormwater Management Division (407-836-5612) once construction has been completed.

Note: Section C of the Elevation Certificate must be marked as Finished Construction.
