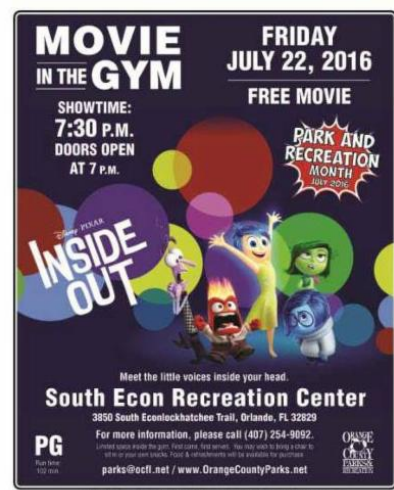
Groups can support Orange County Parks and Recreation by volunteering for monthly projects, such as cleaning up a park or trail, through the [Adopt-a-Park program](#).
