Project Scope of Work

- Excavate and reshape the existing pond bottom and side slopes to create 10 feet of additional flood mitigation volume.
- Install equalizer pipes between the ponds to ensure uniform water level fluctuations between the ponds.
- Install a new pump station and 48" force main that connects to the existing 48" force main to Shingle Creek.
- The pumps will be used to lower the pond water level to create additional volume capacity prior to a major rainfall event.
