Putting the wrong items in your cart can send an entire truckload of recyclables to the landfill.

Keep these common contaminants out of the recycling cart:





NO RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

Lithium-ion batteries can cause fires!



Visit Call2Recycle.org to find a convenient disposal location, or bring them to a county household hazardous waste (HHW) drop-off location or community collection event.

Cover all terminals with tape and separate from other batteries.

Flattened boxes

PAPER

Mail & paperboard (shoe & cereal boxes)

How do I prepare my recyclables?

- · Leave items loose in the cart (no plastic bags)
- · Ensure items are empty and dry
- · Caps can stay on

Materials accepted:

Paint Products • Pesticides • Propane Tanks • Cooking Oil • Fluorescent Lightbulbs Rechargeable Batteries • Computers • Cell Phones • Car Fluids • And More

Paint and chemicals limited to 25 gallons per vehicle. Please cover all lithium battery terminals with tape and separate them from other batteries. **No regular garbage or commercial waste accepted.**
