A residential foster care group home for children who have been removed from their home or caregiver due to abuse, neglect and or abandonment. The facility is comprised of five cottages serving youth 6 to 18+ years of age and a Welcome Center serving youth 0 to 17 years. The Welcome Center provides temporary respite for up to 23 hours while more permanent placement arrangements are being located. Great Oaks Village provides an array of services to the youth including but not limited to the following: Counseling, Case Management, Recreational, Educational, Mentor, Nutritional and arranges Health and Medical services. In addition, eligible youth are able to reside at Great Oaks Village until their 21st birthday in order for them to reach a level of self-sufficiency and be able to live successfully on their own in the community.

Services provided to

Children between the ages of 6-18+, who have been removed from their home by the State of Florida due to abuse, neglect and/ or abandonment.

- Individual, group, family and sibling counseling by professional staff.
 - Linkages with community resources.

Independent Living Preparation

- Job skills and career goals.
- Budgeting and finance.
- Socialization and etiquette.

Educational Services

- Remedial Reading Lab.
 - SAT/ACT/GED preparation.
 - Academic/vocational assessment.
 - Campus-wide tutoring program.
 - State of the art learning/media center.

Services include (continued) Recreational Services Summer camps. School and community activities. Extracurricular activities.
