



Redevelopment Area and Plan

- 7,315-acre redevelopment area
- CRA Plan identifies projects
- 2021 CRA Plan Update
 - Expanded use of CRA revenue
 - Maintained 2028sunset date
 - Caps CRA revenue at \$22M annually

- FY 2024-2025 \$2,300,000








Kirkman Road Extension

- Carrier Drive to Universal Boulevard
 - Under construction
 - Completion 2025
- Partnership project
 - Universal Orlando
 - Florida Department of Transportation
 - Florida Department of Commerce
- FY 2024-2025 \$65,000,000





International Drive Transit Lanes

- Destination Parkway to Sand Lake Road
 - -Shared use lanes
- Design at 100%
- Right-of-Way/easement donations
- Construction 2025
- FY 2024-2025 \$2,630,000





Tangelo Park Pedestrian/Traffic Calming

- Neighborhood traffic assessment
 - Traffic calming
 - Transit shelters
- Planning/Design
- FY 2024-2025 \$200,000





Pedestrian Enhancements

- Design/construction
 - Crosswalks
 - Safety improvements
- 2 signals FY 22-23
- 3 signals FY 23-24
 - Under construction
- FY 2024-2025 \$1,211,565






Tradeshow Boulevard

- Widen roadway from Destination
 Parkway to Universal Boulevard
 - Facilitate freight and future transit corridor
 - Enhance convention center access
- Right-of-Way acquisition
- Construction 2026
- **FY 2024-2025 \$6,725,449**







Destination Parkway

- Landscape medians
 - Was on hold during Kirkman Road construction
- FY 2024-2025 \$100,000



Affordable & Attainable Housing

PROJECTS	PROPOSED BUDGET
Tangelo Park Housing Repair	\$1,050,000
Housing Infill	\$325,000
TOTAL	\$1,375,000



Tangelo Park Housing Repair

- Minor and major homeowner repair program
 - Patterned after Housing & Community Development's existing program
- Limited to Tangelo Park homes
- Income-based (80% AMI)
 - Priority to elderly, disabled, fixed income
 - Priority to major code violations creating health and safety issues





Tangelo Park Housing Repair

- 712 flyers mailed to residences
- 33 applicants approved
 - 24 projects completed
 - \$1.7M expended (\$70,000± per project)
 - -6 projects ready for construction
 - 3 projects pending the bidding process
- FY 2024-2025 \$1,050,000







Housing Infill

- Incentivize infill housing
 - Mixed income residential projects
 - -Consistent with Housing Trust Fund
- FY 2024-2025 \$325,000

- Project implementation in process
 - Neighborhood entrance markers
 - Crosswalks & sidewalks
 - Landscaping & lighting
- Construction complete late summer/early fall 2024

- Phase 1 installation underway
 - -47 signs
 - -Summer 2024 completion
- Phase 2 installation in 2025
 - **-130 signs**
 - Spring 2025completion
